

Hunton CEP School Behaviour Policy Addendum 01/06/20

'Bubble rules' as per the Covid-19 Home School Agreement will be shared with pupils and will sit alongside our current Behaviour policy expectations and practices.

The school will apply strict sanctions, up to and including exclusion to any pupils who wilfully and deliberately refuse to adhere to arrangements of social distancing and deliberately cough or spit at pupils or staff, putting them at risk.

As per the Covid-19 Home School Agreement, pupils will be expected to follow the below:

- Try not to get too close to my friends, other people and teachers
- Tell an adult if I feel unwell
- Try to remember to talk to an adult or my family if there is anything that is worrying me
- Remember not bring things into school from home, or take things home from school
- Remember not to share my things with other children
- Listen carefully to the instructions that my teachers and other adults give me
- Try to remember the new rules at school because they are there to keep me safe
- Use a tissue to cover my nose and mouth if I need to sneeze. I can sneeze or cough into my elbow if I don't have a tissue (catch it-bin it kill it)
- Wash my hands carefully in the way that I have been shown
- Behave well at all times to maintain the safety of myself and others

Rewards and Privileges

Should the child display 'outstanding' work', pupils will not be able to share this with other classes or the Deputy Head Teacher or Associate Head Teacher. Class teachers will substitute this with verbal praise, house points or golden time.

Sanctions

Should 'poor behaviour persist', pupils will not be sent to the Deputy Head Teacher, nor the Associate Head Teacher and if the child needs to be removed from class, this will result in a phone call home and may result in or up to exclusion.
