Future Plans from 1st June

I am sure you will have watched with keen interest the Prime Minister's address to the nation last night. I wanted to keep you as well informed as possible with regard to our response.

The government believes we are in a position to implement a phased re-opening of schools on 1st June 2020 for pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 6. This is part of the government's conditional plan which will be under regular review, based on scientific evidence, meaning that schools will not automatically open on 1st June.

I am sure you have many questions. Rest assured the whole educational community awaits further guidance and once we have received this and considered the best way forward, we will be sharing our plans.

Meanwhile, the hub arrangement will remain open for the children of Key Workers and we will continue to support all parents with our home learning resources. Next week the facility will be at St. Margaret's Collier Street.

Home Education

By the end of this week, teaching staff will be issuing some further learning resources to cover the time before May half-term. Following the holiday, work will then be issued every 2 weeks for Years 2-5. Obviously this arrangement is subject to review depending on school potentially reopening.
