Main barriers to achievement faced by eligible pupils

- Mathematics understanding in year 6, where 100% of pupils are predicted to not reach expected standard by the end of year 6
- Reading and writing understanding in year 6
- Communication and language difficulties i.e. expressing of ideas, language to be improved by group project based on subject of engagement
- Financial constraints preventing pupils experiencing off-site learning
- Pupils’ mental health
