Dear Parents/Carers,

In order to help us with our school improvement and to identify priorities, we have now collated responses from the parent and pupil surveys.

We wish to say thank you to those of you who completed the parents' survey. We had 25 responses this year, so 3% = one person's view. This along with a pupil and staff survey will help inform us of where we can make further improvements as well as highlight our strengths.

From the 35 responses, we were elated that 91% of parents believe that Hunton is a happy school, and that 94 % believe their child is making good progress. We are delighted that a number of responses had 100% of parents agreeing to the following:

- My child feels safe at school
- My child is encouraged by staff to achieve his/her best
- My child has SEND and the school gives them the support they need to succeed
- The school makes sure its pupils are well behaved
- The school is well managed
- The school has an effective governing body
- The school has high expectations for my child
- The school is good at providing extra learning support when required
- The quality of my child's teaching is good
- This Church of England Primary School has a clear Christian vision and explicit Christian values
- I felt well supported when my child joined Hunton CEP School

Most of the remaining questions had a wonderful 94% to 97% positive response.

Although the responses were overwhelmingly positive, we take all feedback very seriously and are considering the negative points, constructive criticism and ideas put forward too. No matter how small the percentage, if there is even one negative comment we really do care and would like to find out why, and how we can make things better for that one person.

In regards to discussing your child's progress and receiving sufficient information on school life we scored 88% and 86% respectively with 84% saying we provide a range of activities outside of lessons in the form of clubs and trips.

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With the newsletter, Teachers2parents, social media as well as parents being able to see staff on the playground or make appointments, we are naturally curious as to what more we can do. After a previous survey, parents indicated that there were too many texts, emails and communication from us. With that feedback we have certainly attempted to lessen this and add more to our newsletter. We are open to any further suggestions, so please don't hesitate to speak with a member of staff in this regard.

Clubs each term can be challenging with outside agencies often charging prohibitive amounts and internal clubs wanting to cater for all interests and talents. Children are often consulted on what clubs they might enjoy but the clubs are not always as well attended as expected. At these times we have consulted with the participants and changed the club immediately in an effort to keep children engaged and enjoying these extra-curricular activities.

We really do endeavour to provide a range of activities outside of lessons whether this be delivering poems to Hunton residents or trips to London. We have an exciting trip to Oxfordshire for Years 3, 4 and 5 visiting the Formula 1 Williams HQ after Easter, plus more trips are organised for all other year groups.

There are other singular comments made which naturally give me concern as I cannot ascertain who the parent is with their anxiety. It makes it more difficult to address the matter and make the improvement for their child. I can only iterate and ask you to come and discuss your concerns with me so solutions can either be found or so I can clarify any misunderstanding with you. We know that we may not always get things right for each individual so please do let us know if you have any concerns.

As you know, we are a church school and our vision of living 'life in all its fullness' by 'striving outside of our comfort zone' along with our values are clearly embedded and we were overjoyed that 100% agreed that we had a clear driving vision and explicit Christian values.

Finally, a big thank you for the wonderful comments you added which mean so much to all the staff. I feel very fortunate to have such a dedicated, caring and fun-loving team who care so much for your children.
