Bannerman class visit to Kent Life on Thursday 24th June 2021

As part of our “Wild and wonderful creatures (animals including humans)” topic this term, we have organised a class trip to Kent Life.

The children will be transported to and from Kent Life by coach, which will be leaving School at 09:30am and returning to School at 3:30pm.

All children will need a packed lunch from home on that day; please use disposable bags rather than lunch boxes or school bags. **Please do not pack any fizzy drinks or any foods which contains nuts.**

All children should wear school uniform and will need a coat if it is cold, as the majority of time will be spent outside. Trainers are permitted to be worn.

Minibeasts workshop: Through games and hands-on activities, pupils explore the minibeasts that live at Kent Life, learning details of beetles, spiders, flying insects etc. and how they survive in their habitats through the seasons. Children will make a minibeast house to take home.

Nocturnal animals workshop: Get the class up close and personal with an array of spectacular nocturnal creatures! Learn about the habitats, adaptations and lifestyles of the animals that come out in the night time. Are you brave enough to say hello to a skunk? This workshop will include a visit to the nature trail.
