Outlined below are the arrangements for reading, homework (which will start from next week) and spellings:

Reading

It is our belief that reading is central to all learning and we hold reading in the highest regard. Therefore, hearing your child read every day for 10 minutes would have an enormous impact on their vocabulary, reading and writing ability and all-round enjoyment!

We kindly ask parents to continue to sign children's reading records when they have heard their child read. We would encourage children who are on a 'unit book' to read the book at least twice before we change it, as this will help your child to develop confidence and fluency in their reading.

Once a week the children will also have an opportunity to choose a book from the KS1 Library, which you can read to your child. The aim of this is to help your child to enjoy reading for pleasure and to hear a range of stories being read aloud.

PE

PE days are on **Mondays** and **Wednesdays** this term. Please ensure children are in correct PE coloured tops, please also note no earrings are to be worn during PE. Children must be able to remove all earrings themselves or earrings should be removed on PE days, before your child comes to school.
