



HUNTON CEP SCHOOL SPORTS PREMIUM FUNDING 2018-2019

In the academic year 2013-2014 the Government announced that they would be providing additional funding to improve the provision of PE and sport in primary schools.

Payment for sports premium is as follows: “Schools with 17 or more eligible pupils receive £16,000 and an additional payment of £10 per pupil.” Hunton CEP School therefore receives **£16,950** for the 2018/2019 academic year.

Schools must use the funding to make additional and sustainable improvement to the quality of PE and sport they offer.

- ALL pupils leaving primary school should be physically literate and have the knowledge, skills and motivation necessary to equip them for a healthy, active lifestyle and lifelong participation in physical activity and sport.
