Dear Year 5 Parents/Carers,

In P.S.H.E/RSE this term, Borton's topic is 'Safety and the Changing Body'. Please see what Year 5 will be learning about in term 3:

- I know the steps to take before sending a message online (using the THINK mnemonic).
- I know some of the possible risks online.
- I can discuss some of the emotional changes through puberty.
- I can identify reliable sources of help with puberty.
- I know that puberty happens at different ages for people.
- I know and understand the process of the menstrual cycle.
- I know the names of the external sexual parts of the body and the internal reproductive organs.

The learning outcomes in red will be broadly taught separately to Year 6 and will form part of the children's Relationships and Sex Education (RSE). As a school, we follow the scheme: 'Kapow' for this subject. Whilst, all of the above is statutory to teach in accordance with the National Curriculum, we felt it was important to let you know in advance.
