

Literacy

This term we will be reading the books 'The Queen's Knickers,' 'Katie in London' and 'See Inside London.'

Comprehension:

- I can identify what the main events in a story
- I can anticipate key events in a story
- I can re-tell a story using new vocabulary in my own words

Word Reading:

- I know the tricky words 'said, so, have, like, some, come, love, do, were, here, little, says, there, when, what, one, out, today.'
- I can read words containing short vowels, compound words, longer words and words ending in -ing, -ed/t, -ed/id, -est
- I can read a sentence that contains Phase 4 words and tricky words

Writing:

- I can form all letters of the alphabet correctly
- I can use 'chunking' to spell longer words
- I can write a caption independently
- I can write a sentence independently

Physical Development

Our PE topic this term is Gymnastics and Games

Gross motor:

- I can hold a shape and balance for 5 seconds
- I can squeeze my muscles when holding a balance to help me stay still
- I can jump and land safely from a height
- I can keep my legs and feet together on a straight roll
- I can stay curled up in the barrel roll
- I can create sequences, travel over, around and through apparatus

Fine motor:

- I can hold a pencil effectively using the tripod grip

Shape:

- I can select, compose and decompose shapes for a purpose
- I can rotate and manipulate shapes
- I can copy 2D shape pictures
- I can find 2D shapes within 3D shapes

- I know some similarities and differences between London in the past and now including transport and landmarks
