Year 1 - Phonics:

- Phase 5 Grow the Code. New graphemes including 'tch' match and 'wr'

 wrist
- Alternative sounds for graphemes e.g. 'a' making 'or' sound as in water and 'a' making 'o' sound in want
- New tricky words including—'once', 'laugh', 'because', 'eye'.

Science

Plants (Light and Dark)

What is the best place for plants to grow?

- I know how to identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees.
- I know how to observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants.
- I know how to find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy.
- I can make simple predictions based on a question.
- I can observe something closely using simple equipment.
- I can talk about what I have found out and how I found it out.



PE

Striking and Fielding

- I can roll a ball towards an object.
- I can track and receive a rolling ball.
- I can send and receive a ball with my feet.
- I can develop my throwing and catching skills.
- I can send and receive a ball using a racket.

Invasions

Geography

Weather and Fieldwork Skills

What is it like to live in the UK?

- I can generate enquiry questions.
- I can use weather data collected over time to make decisions

Mechanisms – Wheels and Axles

- I know that axles are used in structures and mechanisms to make parts turn in a circle.
- I know that wheels need to be round to rotate and move.
- I know that for a wheel to move it must be attached to a rotating axle.
- I know that an axle moves within an axle holder which is fixed to the vehicle or toy.
- I know that the frame of a vehicle (chassis) needs to be balanced.
- I can make functioning axles which are assembled into a main supporting structure.
- I can adapt mechanisms when they do not work as they should.
